Aimhigher Plus is a new initiative targeting areas of the West Midlands where the progression of young people to higher education is lower than GCSE attainment suggests it should be.

Aimhigher Plus will build on the extensive higher education outreach already provided by universities and colleges, and develop new and exciting opportunities for young people from disadvantaged backgrounds.

We are inviting secondary schools and colleges in Aimhigher Plus areas to work with us to raise attainment and increase social mobility.



What is Aimhigher Plus?

Aimhigher Plus is part of the National Collaborative Outreach Programme (NCOP), supporting the government's goals to double the proportion of disadvantaged young people entering higher education (HE) by 2020, increase by 20% the number of students from ethnic minority groups and address the underrepresentation of young men from disadvantaged backgrounds.


Aimhigher Plus is one of 29 NCOP consortia and has been awarded up to £9 million to operate the programme to December 2020.

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

Who is Aimhigher Plus for?

- Students in Years 9 to 13 who live in specified postcode areas
- Aimhigher Plus will work with you to identify eligible students you feel would benefit most from our programme, and how we can support your work to improve attainment and destinations.

Existing higher education outreach will continue to provide a wide range of opportunities for students who do not live in Aimhigher Plus areas.



What's on offer?

Aimhigher Plus will give your students access to a wide range of aspiration and attainment raising activities and opportunities to explore higher education and new Degree and Higher Apprenticeship options. There are two levels of involvement:

Intensive

For schools and colleges with significant numbers of eligible students

Intensive schools and colleges will have:

- Up to £10,000 per annum to enable a member of staff to oversee your involvement, meet the costs of transport / staff cover and the sharing of data to target and evaluate the programme
- A Graduate Ambassador, to enrich your CEIAG curriculum and support students on the programme
- 4 undergraduate mentors to support students
- A programme of FREE aspiration and attainment raising activities
- Opportunities to develop the programme to meet the needs of your students
- CPD for your staff and information events for parents and carers.

Intensive schools and colleges will need to:

 Identify a member of staff with time to support the programme and the Graduate Ambassador and mentors

- Work with us, to tailor the programme to meet your needs
- Support learner engagement
- Share student-level data to enable Aimhigher to target and track students' attainment and destinations
- Support us in gaining consent for tracking and evaluation, using documentation provided by Aimhigher.

A sample of intensive NCOP schools / colleges will also be invited to participate in research to explore young people's attitudes to careers, progression and higher education.

Less Intensive

For schools and colleges with smaller numbers of eligible students

Less intensive schools and colleges will have access to a programme of FREE aspiration and attainment raising activities, including masterclasses, taster days, conferences, IAG events and other outreach activity.

What about other schools and colleges?

Aimhigher Plus will intensify our work in target wards, and build on the extensive outreach activity already available in the West Midlands. Through our wider work we will continue to provide outreach opportunities for disadvantaged students with the potential to be considering higher education, wherever they live.

How will Aimhigher Plus help your school or college?

Involvement in the Aimhigher Plus NCOP will help you:

- Meet your statutory duty to provide careers guidance
- Generate evidence in support of CEIAG Quality Award submissions
- Improve the Progress 8 and Attainment 8 outcomes of disadvantaged students
- Improve KS4 and KS5 destinations.
