PATHWAY 1 FULL-TIME HIGHER EDUCATION IN UK

THE BIG ADVANTAGE OF THIS SECTION IS:

- 37,000+ course options
- 370+ different unis/colleges
- And almost all can be found and applied for in <u>one place</u>......



UNI TUITION FEES (FOR UK STUDENTS, 2017)

- Tuition fees = <u>£9,250pa</u>, but you can take out a <u>Fee Loan</u>
 so **YOU PAY NOTHING UP FRONT**
- + You can take out a <u>Maintenance Loan</u> of up to <u>£8,430pa</u>*, but then your total "debt" would exceed <u>£53,000 + interest</u> (*£7,097 at home; £8,430 away from home; £11,002 in London)
- After a year, you pay back at <u>9% of any income you earn over</u> <u>£21K</u> (= £30 per month on a salary of £25,000)
- BUT THE "DEBT" IS WRITTEN OFF AFTER 30 YEARS
 so IT'S NOT ACTUALLY A "DEBT"

- and estimates say that only 5% will pay it back in full

1) <u>CHOOSING A DEGREE COURSE</u>

- Please tell students to stop being so boring!
- Choices are still very traditional
- 75% of students apply for 25% of courses
- Be imaginative!
- Choose a degree that's going to motivate you UCAS Chief Executive Officer, 2016
- Be aware that 70% of graduate jobs are open to graduates of any discipline, but also that ...
- ... graduates with no work experience have little or no chance of getting a graduate job

EMPLOYABILITY SKILLS & BEHAVIOURS SOUGHT BY GRADUATE EMPLOYERS

CONSIDER THE 'SANDWICH' OPTION

Degrees with a professional year/sandwich placement

- Unis like Aston/Bath/Brunel/Harper Adams/ Loughborough/Surrey/Sussex offer it across a wide range of subjects
- Placement year <u>usually</u> paid (Aston average = £16,000)
- ... and tuition fee reduced to £1,800 for UK students ... (£0 at Wolverhampton)
- Boosts employability; degree results up to 30% better

<u>Or</u> if not a placement year, seek out internships, part-time or voluntary work and positions of responsibility

OR CONSIDER A YEAR (OR LESS) **ABROAD**

Examples:

Aston:

• 70 partner unis in 28 countries; worldwide workplace & school placements <u>Birmingham</u>:

• Over 300 partner unis in 38 countries

Lancaster:

 60 partner unis in Europe, USA, Canada, Mexico, Australia, NZ, Hong Kong, Thailand, China

Sussex:

• Year abroad at 140 unis in 34 countries worldwide

<u>Swansea</u>:

- 100 partner unis worldwide, open to ALL students in 2nd semester Y2
- + summer programmes in Africa/Asia/Europe/Australia/Europe/N America

<u>Modern Languages</u> /<u>American Studies</u> and many <u>European / International</u> degrees will also have an integrated year abroad

Maximum tuition fee = £1350 for UK/EU students;

Brexit impact still very uncertain

CONSIDER A JOINT, COMBINED OR MULTIDISCIPLINARY DEGREE

"Why are all you Brits taking single-subject degrees?" (ex-CEO of Google) "The key to 21st century employability lies in positioning yourself at the intersections between academic subject disciplines." (Dr Paul Redmond, Manchester Uni)

Combine 2 subjects

Examples: History and Spanish or Physics and Music Performance

Take a major/minor course

Example: Maths <u>with</u> Management

Combine 3 subjects

Example: *Triple Honours at Sheffield (19 subject choices)*

Or a multidisciplinary course

Examples: Natural Sciences or Liberal Arts or Arts & Sciences

I would argue that the best is one that is <u>THE BEST FIT</u> ... FOR YOU AND FOR THE COURSE YOU WANT TO STUDY

- But you're <u>not</u> entitled to <u>UK</u> tuition fee loans/student loans
- And Brexit will impact from 2019 (still unclear, but may affect students already on course too)

WORLDWIDE

- Medical Doorway back-up options for Medicine around Europe
- Multinational degrees like:
- **ESCP Europe** (BSc Management: Y1 London; Y2 Madrid/Paris/Turin; Y3 Berlin)
- Bocconi (World Bachelor in Business: Los Angeles/Hong Kong/Milan)

OBSERVATIONS ON "PATHWAY 4" (1)

Aston University:

- You need to be highly-motivated to work and study simultaneously
- But the demand for digital skills far exceeds supply

CGI:

- Apprentices form strong friendship groups and can afford a good social life with lots of discounts off comedy/theatre/music etc
- CGI can cover up to £1,000 relocation costs
- You're a permanent employee, provided you meet expectations (but not always the case with other providers)
- Tom (CGI apprentice I met this year): "You've got to be very driven"


