

Question do's and don'ts

Don't just ask about entry requirements

 Don't ask very general questions 'why should I go to your University'

 Do ask questions specific to your interests

Do take notes







#### Example questions

- What is unique about the course at your university?
- Am I guaranteed a place in Accommodation?
- Is your University based on a campus? Which campus (if more than one)?
- Can you tell me about the Sports Facilities?
- How can your university support my disability?
- Are there opportunities to study abroad as part of the course?
- When are open days? Do I need to book?

## Why attend open days?

- Experience <u>first hand</u> where you may learn AND possibly live
- Detailed course research
- What else can a University offer you?
- Ask questions
- Gut instinct

#### "I don't know what to ask"

#### Detailed questions about your subject area

- What does the course cover?
- How many hours a week will I be in timetabled teaching?
- What assessment methods are used?
- How will you learn?
- What's the split between lectures, tutorials and selfdirected study?
- What size are tutorial groups?
- Does it have the facilities you expect?
- What opportunities are there for you to broaden and deepen your understanding of the subject?
- Are placements or study abroad on offer, where are they how are they organised, are they paid, how do they affect tuition fees?

#### "I don't know what to ask"

#### **Questions to ask current students**

- What is the Accommodation like?
- Are there options for catered and self catered Accommodation?
- What is the town/city like?
- How have you found the course so far?
- What are the facilities/opportunities like?
- Which clubs/societies are you part of?





#### Open day do's and don'ts

- Do keep an open mind when selecting universities to visit
- Do be prepared
- Do plan a schedule before you visit
- Do be a motivated visitor
- Do think about what is important to you
- If you visit with your friends, do visit separate talks/activities and meet up for breaks
- Parents/carers can help you to make the most out of open days, but don't leave all the talking/decision making to them
- Don't try to visit too many subject areas
- Don't run out of time there's a lot to fit in
