BROADENING HORIZONS

KS3 & 4

12th & 19th May

This virtual event is targeted at students in KS3 and KS4, as they Broaden their Horizons and learn about the world of work. During this pre-recorded 2 part event students will hear from an award winning motivational speaker and set goals for the future. They will hear from employers from a range of different career pathways and try to guess their job titles. Students will then explore in more depth what is involved in a job application process and what makes you an employable candidate in an online video interview.

2nd & 9th June

Aimhigher Plus have partnered with Social Action charity Envision to bring you a virtual event based around how young people can develop valuable employability skills, through social action work in their local communities. Students who may be missing out on traditional work experience this year can benefit from this event. The event will encourage students to reflect on life experiences where they have developed transferable skills to benefit opportunities for the future. This event is suited to students in years 10 and 12 who may have missed out on work experience.

MAKE YOUR MOVE

POST 16

9th & 16th June

Ready to Make Your Move? This bi-annual event has been developed into a virtual online set of workshops designed for Post 16 students who may be thinking about university as an option or would like to know more about how university works. Part 1 will explore what university is all about, how to choose courses and places to study and the application process, as well as how to write a great personal statement. Part 2 will explore student life, accommodation and how to finance a university degree. All the information you need to decide whether university is right for you, is right here!

NEXT STEPS

YEAR 11

23rd June

Next Steps will give pupils valuable insight into taking the next steps after school towards college or sixth form. This workshop will focus on the skills needed to transition from GCSE to FE successfully and, with help from a motivational speaker, will prepare young people for their changing futures.

TRANSITION EVENT

POST 16

30th June & 7th July

This virtual event is targeted at Post 16 students, as they transition from sixth-form or college onto university. During this event students will hear from current university students and lecturers to gain top tips about university life. Covering a range of topics such as cooking, university study skills and well-being, students will get an insight into university life, what will be expected of them and the skills they need to succeed as a university student. Students will experience a university lecture, get an insight into student support services and have the opportunity to ask questions to current university students to hear about their experiences.

ROLE MODELS CAREERS EVENT

POST 16

14th July 2020

A one-off virtual event aimed at Post 16 students, this session will explore the experiences of four selected Role Models to highlight their chosen pathways that led them to their current careers. At such an important stage of their education, students will have the opportunity to learn about possible routes after FE from those who experienced them first-hand, to reach where they are now. Students will then have the chance to engage with what they've learned through an activity combining the Role Models' stories with knowledge of potential pathways.'
