SUPPORTING ACADEMIC ATTAINMENT

This year, we are excited to offer bespoke programmes to support learners' numeracy, literacy, oracy and revision skills to enhance their in-school learning. Through this offer, we aim to support academic attainment while motivating learners to reach their full potential in these specific areas.

LEVEL-UP LITERACY

Offered to Years 7-9, Level-Up
Literacy is a computer-based literacy
programme using the platform
Lexia. The programme focuses
on three main areas: word study,
grammar and comprehension.
The programme is tailored to each
learner: firstly, targeting whatever
learners struggle with most to a
greater extent, secondly, using a
step-by-step style to ensure it is

engaging, but not frustrating for them. Lexia has been shown to be an impactful programme and is recommended by the Education Endowment Foundation.

We invite learners who meet widening participation criteria*, who are also currently achieving a borderline 3 / 4 grade in GCSE English, to engage in this programme.

SPEAK OUT CHALLENGE

Offered to Year 10, this programme will be delivered in collaboration with Speakers Trust via full-day workshops. The workshops are designed to support young people to improve their oracy skills, developing their ability to express themselves confidently and clearly. They will include oracy exercises, such as public speaking and persuasion tasks, with a focus on improving students ability to express themselves confidently

and clearly. By taking part, students will understand the importance of speaking and listening skills, including the behaviours and language necessary to become a strong, effective communicator.

We invite learners who meet widening participation criteria*, who are also currently achieving a borderline 3 / 4 grade in GCSE English Language, to engage in this programme.

Offered to Year 11, MyTutor is an online tutoring programme, where learners are matched with undergraduate students from UK universities. The undergraduate students are experts in their subject and as a fellow young person who is excelling in the same courses learners are studying for, the undergraduates become a role model for Year 11 learners. By looking at previous MyTutor programmes, we can see that learners who

attend 10 to 12 tutoring sessions with MvTutor increase a whole grade from mock to final grade on average, making this a highly impactful programme.

We invite learners who meet widening participation criteria* who are also currently achieving a borderline 3 / 4 grade in GCSE English or Maths, to engage in this programme.

FUTURE FEST: YEAR 11 RESIDENTIAL

Future Fest is a Year 11 residential focusing heavily on revision and aims to support learners' transition to Post-16 education. Research continues to show the positive effects of immersive residential experiences when connecting with learners who may have low aspirations or are less engaged with their studies. Throughout the programme, we will offer talks and workshops on core subjects, revision techniques, coping with exam stress, as well as general advice and guidance when considering post-16 options.
