Aimhigher West Midlands is a partnership of universities, schools and colleges who work together to improve social mobility by widening participation in all forms of higher education.


Based at some of the region's leading universities and colleges, a team of Aimhigher staff support our programmes working with hundreds of colleagues in schools, careers organisations, charities, and employers. Aimhigher inspire, inform and encourage young people to think about their future educational and career choices.

We help young people to:

 Become motivated and confident about their learning and career progression

- Explore the world of higher education and what it might mean for them
- Make informed decisions about their future

We provide a vast range of activities to help young people explore higher education and how it might help to fulfil their career ambitions. Every week hundreds of young people benefit from our work, exploring campuses, working with academics and being mentored by current and former university students.



Our research shows that the students we work with have more aspirational career plans and are more motivated to succeed. Aimhigher students that engaged within one or more Aimhigher activities were 1.5 times more likely to enter higher education than young people from similarly disadvantaged backgrounds who did not.

Aimhigher helps to address many barriers that young people face in terms of progressing to HE by increasing their knowledge in higher

myths students may believe about higher education. Subsequently, students report that they are now more likely to progress to higher education.

Some of the wider benefits reported include improvements in learners' behaviour, school attendance, confidence, motivation and school attainment, all of which could help to increase the likelihood of atture progression to higher education.
